LBGTA Panel Program – teams of students lead discussions in classrooms, residence halls, and support units.

- ✓ Supports and empowers LGBT campus leaders and group advisors.
- ✓ Collaborates on networking, events and support for LGBT graduate students.
- ✓ Leads and collaborates on campus-wide educational programs, training, and resource development on sexual orientation and gender identity issues.
- ✓ Coordinates responses to anti-LGBT bias incidents.
- ✓ Provides consultation for faculty and staff on LGBT student and community issues.
- ✓ Leads and collaborates on research initiatives on LGBT campus climate and student identities.
- ✓ Provides administrative support for three LGBT focused scholarships (check our website for more information).
- ✓ Is committed to working with all members of the MSU community in a multicultural, social justice context.
